Day
1

Arrive into Zurich

We assemble at the Cochin International Airport to board your flight to Zurich.

Welcome to Zurich – Switzerland’s largest metropolis. After we finish the immigration formalities we drive you to your hotel. After the long journey you can freshen up and relax in your hotel room.

Overnight at your hotel in Zurich (Dinner)

2

Mt. Titlis with Ice Flyer Ride and Lucerne

After a continental breakfast, we proceed on an exciting full day excursion to Mt. Titlis and Lucerne. We begin the tour with a visit to Mt. Titlis, which at 10,000 ft is the highest peak in central Switzerland. As you journey to Mt. Titlis through a series of three different cable car rides, you will be amazed as the scenery changes from green meadows, scenic lakes to snow clad mountains. See over 200 cable cars sporting different flags. Lookout for cable car number 73 that carries the Indian flag! The last leg of the ascent will be in the world’s first rotating cable car called the ‘**Titlis Rotair**’.

At Mt. Titlis you have free time to play and enjoy in the snow, visit the Ice Cave or just relax at the restaurant. At the Terrace on top of the Mt. Titlis summit station, weather permitting, you could take an unforgettable ride on the “**Ice - Flyer**” an enclosed ski lift that travels only a few meters over the Titlis Glacier.

We later proceed for an **orientation tour of Lucerne**, one of the six most frequently visited cities in the World. See the **Lion Monument**, ‘Lowendenkmal’ hewn from a limestone cliff to commemorate the bravery and loyalty of Swiss Guards. You may take a stroll across the **Kappelbrucke** - the world’s oldest covered wooden bridge, originally built in 1333 over the Reuss river. You have **free time at Schwanenplatz** to shop for Swiss army knives, chocolates, watches, souvenirs, etc.

Rhine Falls at Schaffhausen - Visit Drubba in the Black Forest

After a continental breakfast, we checkout and proceed to Germany. Visit the **Rhine Falls at Schaffhausen**. The Rhine Falls provides a magnificent spectacle. Across a width of 150 meters (492 feet) and a height of 23 meters, 600 m³ (21,189 cubic feet) of water plunge over the falls in the summer.

Then proceed to the **Black Forest region of Germany**, where at Drubba you can see a demonstration of how Cuckoo clocks are made. Buy one of the original Cuckoo clocks as a souvenir. You also have an opportunity to eat the famous Black Forest Cake.

Later we continue our journey towards Heidelberg. Check in at the hotel and relax.

Guided tour of Magnificent Cologne Cathedral

After a continental breakfast, we drive to Cologne, famous for Eau de Cologne, where we see the magnificent **Cologne Cathedral on a guided tour**. This 515 feet tall gothic Cathedral took six centuries

to build and is Germany's most visited monument.

Indulge in some **shopping in Cologne**. Cologne's city center is a paradise for shoppers, with something to suit every taste and every wish.

After lunch, proceed to Amsterdam, the Netherlands' capital, known for its artistic heritage, elaborate canal system and narrow houses with gabled facades, legacies of the city's 17th-century Golden Age. Its Museum District houses works by Rembrandt and Vermeer at the Rijksmuseum, the Van Gogh Museum and modern art at the Stedelijk.

Keukenhof Gardens - Visit Zaanse Schans - Guided Tour of Rotterdam

After a continental breakfast, checkout of the hotel and proceed to visit the Keukenhof Gardens, the famed National Flower Exhibition. Like the million visitors that journey here annually, you will be spellbound at the sight of beautiful displays of over seven million Tulips, Daffodils, Narcissi and other flowers (from 20th May onwards, do a city tour of Hague and visit Madurodam, home to a range of miniature replicas of famous Dutch landmarks).

Then proceed to Zaanse Schans, Netherlands.

The Zaanse Schans is one of the highlights of the Netherlands, just outside Amsterdam. Be part of a vibrant and stunning living and working community that dates back to the 18th and 19th centuries. It's packed with wooden windmills, barns, houses and museums and built in the typically Dutch wooden architectural style, relocated here piece by piece since 1961. The Zaanse Schans will easily fill half a day – there is so much to see, taste, smell and experience!

Take a walk through the stunning buildings and the unique peat meadow landscape. Come and watch traditional crafts such as clog- and cheese-making or visit the windmills and traditional buildings.

Enjoy a guided tour of Rotterdam.

Discover the different facets of Rotterdam with a customizable itinerary on this half-day private walking tour that ends with a relaxing cruise. With the help of your personalized guide, admire the city's modern architecture as well as the buildings that survived WWII. Wander around Museumpark, the Rotterdam Centrum and the Old Harbor dating back to the 14th century.

Canal Cruise in Bruges

After a continental breakfast, checkout and proceed to Bruges, the capital of West Flanders in northwest Belgium.

Bruges is distinguished by its canals, cobbled streets and medieval buildings. Its port, Zeebrugge, is an important center for fishing and European trade. The city-center Markt features horse-drawn carriage rides and 17th-century houses converted into restaurants and cafes, as well as the 13th-century belfry with its 47-bell carillon and 83m tower with panoramic views.

On arrival, enjoy a **canal cruise** in this beautiful medieval city. Viewing the city from the water gives it a totally different feel than by foot.

Overnight at your hotel in Bruges (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Onto Paris

After a continental breakfast, checkout and proceed to Paris. Arrive Paris and check in at the hotel.

Evening is free for **shopping**.
