In the afternoon, visit the Toul Sleng Genocide Museum, a former high school used by the Khmer Rouge for torture and interrogation. Return to Phnom Penh for an overnight stay at the hotel.

Day 03: Phnom Penh – Siem Reap

After breakfast at your hotel in Phnom Penh, you will be transferred to Siem Reap. Upon your arrival in Siem Reap, you will be transferred to your hotel and checked in. The rest of the day is at your leisure. You can explore the city of Siem Reap or relax at your hotel. In the evening, you can enjoy a traditional Khmer dinner at a local restaurant. Then return for an overnight stay at the hotel in Siem Reap.

Day 04: Angkor Complex Tour
