**Day
1****BOARD FROM COCHIN – FLY TO KUALALUMPUR - OVERNIGHT AT FLIGHT**

Board your flight for your much awaited and most thrilling holiday to the most interesting destinations of Fareast Malaysia. Overnight at Flight.

**Day
2****ARRIVAL KUALALUMPUR – PUTRAJAYA TOUR – CITY TOUR -KL TOWER VISIT – OVERNIGHT AT HOTEL**

On arrival at Kuala Lumpur airport, fresh up from airport. Later proceed Putrajaya tour. Approximately 50 minutes drive out of Kuala Lumpur is Putrajaya, Malaysia's new federal administrative centre. The architecture in Putrajaya is predominantly modern Arabic in style. Later we will take you for City tour and KL Tower visit including entrance fees. The Kuala Lumpur tower, which was opened in 1996. The height of the tower is 421 meters and reputed to be the highest in Asia and the 3rd highest in the world. You will be taken in a high speed lift to the top level in the height of 395 meters from where you can see the magnificent view of the city. An unforgettable sight of Kuala Lumpur by night. Overnight at hotel. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

**Day
3****BATU CAVES TOUR – DAY TRIP TO GENTING HIGHLAND – OVERNIGHT AT HOTEL**

Morning after breakfast, move out for a day trip to Genting highlands. Enroute visit Batu Caves, the temple of Lord Muruga. On the way to Genting Highlands enjoy cable car ride. Enjoy the SkyTropolis Indoor Theme Park ticket. Evening drive back to hotel. Overnight at hotel. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

**Day
4****MALACA TOUR- OVERNIGHT AT HOTEL**

Morning after breakfast proceed to Historical Malacca tour. It is the oldest Malaysian city on the Strait of Malacca, having become a successful entrepôt in the era of the Malacca Sultanate. Visit the famous gateway, 'Porta De Santiago' and the ruins of St Paul's Church lined with 17th century Dutch tombstones. Next on the list is 'Red Square' - the salmon pink Dutch administrative buildings which today houses the Malacca Museum and government offices. After lunch, we visit the 'Abode of Merciful Clouds' or the Cheng Hoon Teng Temple – the only temple where you can find 3 major doctrines of local Chinese beliefs of Taoism, Buddhism and Confucianism. Lastly, take a stroll along the famous Jonker Street which also houses rows of antique shops Malacca's style. Later transfer to hotel. Overnight at hotel. [Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner]
